UPDATED PARENT INFORMATION DELTA LEVEL 2

September 8th 2021



Welcome back to school. **We are OPEN TOMORROW** (Thursday Sept 9th) We are looking forward to getting your children back to school. You are probably as well?....Just a few reminders about how we are organised at Level 2.

Masks are not mandated for children but are able to be worn if parents choose. They do need to be worn correctly however and not fiddled with all day.

The following guidelines have been developed to reduce the numbers of children and adults congregating in any one place at the same time. We need to observe the 2m outdoor social distancing rules at Level 2 during those drop off and pick times.



During the day children are not required to maintain those distances as we operate under a different set of rules.

Playgrounds throughout the school are open. Drinking Fountains are open but will be cleaned 3x during the day.

MORNINGS - Monday to Friday

- **No one** should arrive at school before 8.30am.
- Parents will use the **drop zone** and let children walk into their classroom under their own steam carrying their own bags OR **drop children in Parkland Cres** and let them walk in to school and go directly to their classrooms.
- Parents are encouraged **not to go to their child's class** between 8.30am and 8.50am between Monday and Thursday.
- *Parents of New Entrants can and should visit Room 1 or 10 with their child as they begin their school life. Parents are also invited to walk with their child of any age if they are anxious in any way. We simply ask that you scan the school's QR Code OR sign the contact tracing register.*
- *If there are any issues you wish to discuss with teachers you are also welcome to do so. Simply scan the QR Code or sign the Contact Tracing Register.*
- *Parents are welcome to come into the office area but you will simply need to wear a mask, keep a 2m distance and scan the QR Code or complete the Contact Tracing Register by the door.*

AFTERNOONS - Monday to Friday

- Parents/ Caregivers **should not go to their child's class** or wait outside the classroom.
- **Rooms 1, 2, 3, 4, 7, 8,10, 14** will be taken to either the quad area between the office and Room 4 (**NETBALL COURT**) OR the back entrance at 2.55pm. (Obviously the entrance will be determined by which one parents choose to collect children from.)

- **Rooms 5,6,11,12,13** will be taken to the **BASKETBALL COURT** behind Room 3 & 4 and will then use the Kindergarten driveway to leave school. Again, those children that are collected from the back entrance will be escorted in that direction.

Work out which room your child is in and if you wish to meet them at the front or back of the school.

If you collect your child in the afternoons from the front entrance of the school and they are in any of the following rooms....

Room 1, Room 2, Room 3, Room 4, Room 7, Room 8, Room 10 or Room 14

You will meet them on the NETBALL COURT after school



If you collect your child in the afternoons from the front entrance of the school and they are in any of the following rooms....

Room 5, Room 6, Room 11, Room 12, or Room 13

You will meet them on the BASKETBALL COURT after school

If you normally collect your child from the back entrance they will meet you at the **Fitness Circuit** area.



If you have children across both groups of rooms we will leave it up to you to determine which area you wish to meet them after school that best suits your needs.
