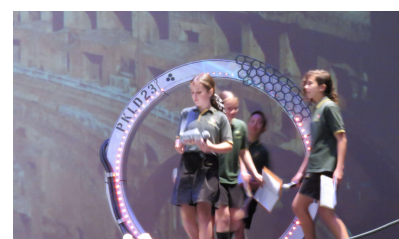
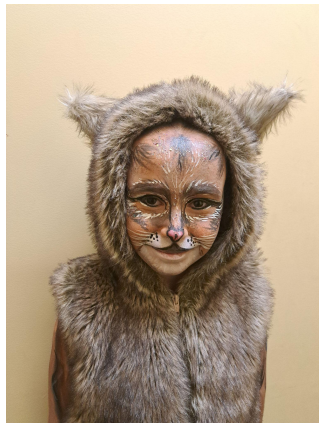
Welcome back to the third term or the second half of winter! A warm welcome to the following children and their families who have joined the Parkland School Community this term.
