The Palmerston North Weetbix Tryathlon is being held on Tuesday, March 19th, 2024 at Ongley Park. This is open to all children aged 6 years old to 15 years old (on the day of the event). Children can enter



individually or as a team. Parents and caregivers can register their child/children online via the Weetbix Tryathlon website.
